Safety Instructions

- Whilst all care has been taken to remove sharp edges, care must be taken when cleaning or handling to prevent risk of injury from exposed metal edges.
- DO NOT overload the table top or shelf causing it to bend.



Assembly

1. Remove all protective film, taking care to avoid scratching the surface. Place the shelf on its side on the floor.
2. Insert the legs into the sockets situated at each corner of the shelf, lining up the socket with the line marked on the leg. (Fig.1)
3. Use grub screws to loosely fix the shelf to the legs, then stand upright. (Fig. 2,3 and 4)
4. Position the table top onto the legs, ensuring each leg is firmly located in its corresponding corner socket.
5. Fix the table top in place using the remaining grub screws. Ensure the table top is both level and securely fixed. (Fig.6)

Note: Adjust the feet if necessary to level the table.

Before using for the first time VOGUE recommend the table is cleaned thoroughly with a suitable cleaning agent. Remove all cleaning residues and dry thoroughly.





Cleaning

- Clean the table regularly using a cleaning agent suitable for use with stainless steel and galvanised surfaces.
- Always remove cleaning agents residues, this can discolour the surface.
- Never leave any surface damp as this may cause discoloration.
